Tom Appleton has worked with a number of East Suffolk organisations such as FirstLight Festival, Britten Pears Arts, Jubilee Opera, Aldeburgh Jubilee Hall, Cohere Arts CiC, and the Marina Theatre, Lowestoft. He was a member of St. Paul's Cathedral Choir, the National Youth Choirs of Great Britain, and the Monteverdi Choir. He was Director of Music Outreach at Gresham's School, a research and development consultant for Britten Sinfonia, and currently sits on the Creatives Advisory Group at both Norwich Theatre and the Theatre Royal, Bury St. Edmunds. Elenor has been a professional soprano for 14 years, performing as a soloist and consort member around the world. He has performed recitals in many cathedrals throughout the UK and Europe.

Baritone Robert Gildon studied singing at Manhattan School of Music, New York, the Tanglewood Music Center, Aspen Music Festival and the Britten Pears School at Snape. Recent work includes appearances at the Buxton Festival, Garsington Opera, Grange Festival, London Contemporary Music Festival, G & S Festival and with the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment and the LSO. He lives in Suffolk with 5 dogs, goats, chickens, peacocks, bees and a tortoise.

Jeremy has been playing baroque and modern cello around East Anglia since the mid-1990s, and is a familiar sight in orchestra and chamber music concerts.
